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### Pre-anesthetic Blood Testing Requirements

Advances in anesthesia and surgery have made routine procedures safer, thus reducing the risk of complications. However, problems may arise due to pre-existing conditions not evident in the preoperative exam. To avoid or reduce the risk of such complications, we require pre-anesthetic testing. While such testing does not guarantee the absence of problems during anesthesia, it may allow detection of risks that may be responsible for such complications.

**Pets up to 3 years old** **\$75**  
Includes: PCV, total protein, creatinine, blood urea nitrogen ALT, ALP, glucose, and electrolytes

**Pets 3-7 years old** **\$127**  
Includes all tests above plus albumin, globulin, calcium, phosphorus, bilirubin, cholesterol & CBC

**Pets 8 years and older** **\$135**  
Must have a full blood panel done 24 hours before surgery procedure

**\*If anesthetic complications occur during the surgical procedure, additional charges may occur in order to intervene.**

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### ECG Recommendation Price Varies

Current research has shown that heart disease is very prevalent in cats and older dogs. Unfortunately, heart disease is difficult to diagnose in these patients until severe damage has been done to the heart. We strongly recommend a pre-anesthetic ECG as the best test to screen your pet for heart disease.

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### Laser Surgery Price Varies

Using a CO2 laser for surgical procedures reduces the pain, bleeding, and swelling for your pet. The laser seals off blood vessels, nerve endings, and lymphatics, which results in less bleeding, inflammation, and pain at the surgical site. Less inflammation and pain improves your pet's recovery time.
